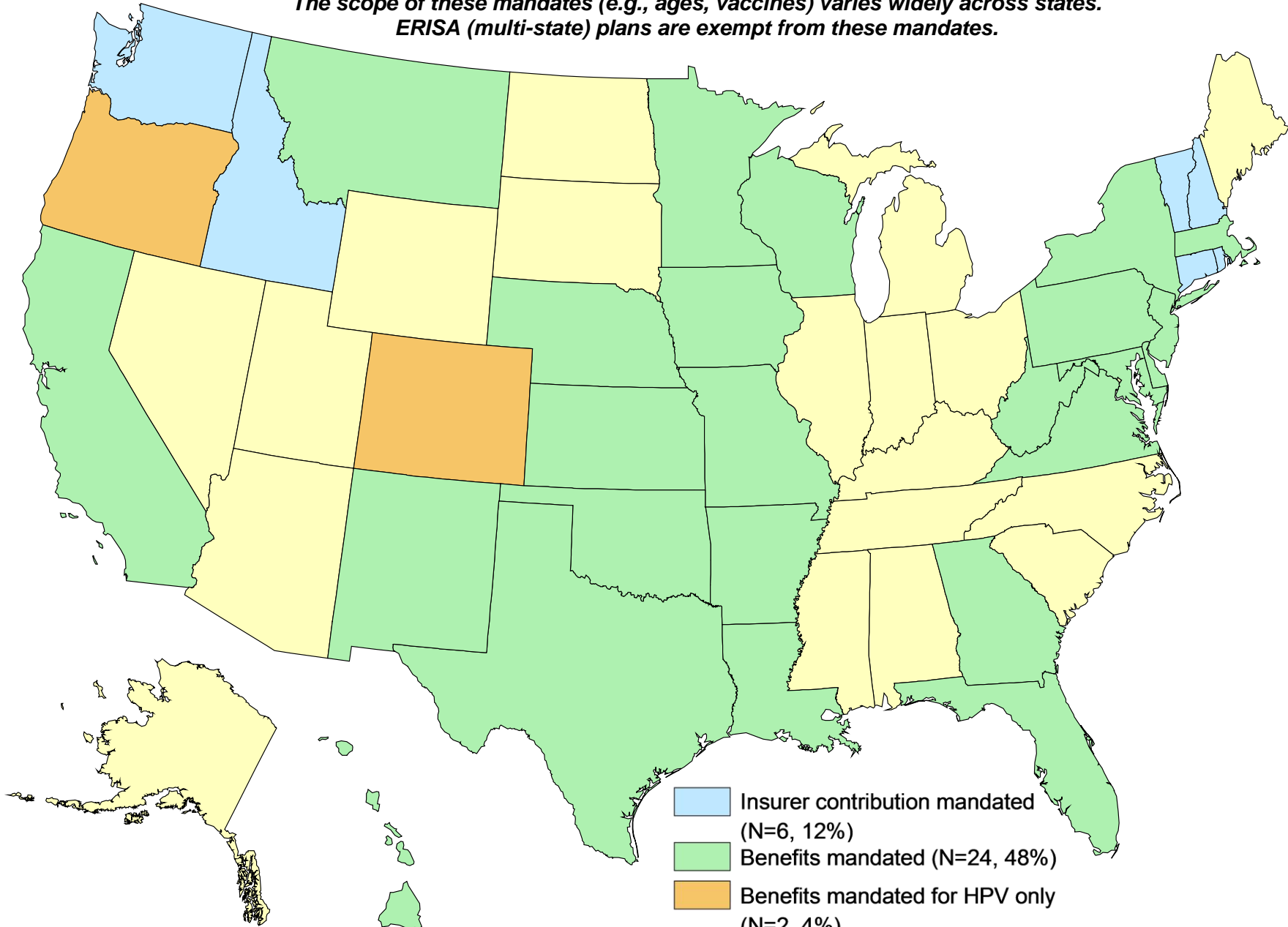




IMMUNIZATION-RELATED INSURANCE MANDATES

*The scope of these mandates (e.g., ages, vaccines) varies widely across states.
ERISA (multi-state) plans are exempt from these mandates.*



- Insurer contribution mandated (N=6, 12%)
- Benefits mandated (N=24, 48%)
- Benefits mandated for HPV only (N=2, 4%)
- No mandate (N=18, 36%)
