UNOFFICIAL NOTES [these notes have not been reviewed by CDC]

- **Pfizer Under 5**
 - Pfizer has pushed back the timeline again. More complete data likely to be submitted to FDA in mid to late February. This will impact how many doses are available during launch. If all goes well, April launch date Pfizer under 5.
 - This will no longer be split between two age groups. Will be available for 6mths-4 years.
 - CDC is expecting similar demand as 5-11 rollout, but more pressure on providers for this cohort.
 - Packaging:
 - 100 dose min order
 - 10 dose vial
 - 9 months in the freezer
 - MAROON cap
 - Diluent required
 - CDC/Pfizer working on a comparative chart with ORANGE, GRAY, and MAROON.
 - CDC is encouraging jurisdictions to push providers to avoid missed opportunity to vaccinate this age group. Waste is acceptable but should be submitted to the waste report.

- **Pfizer Gray Cap**
 - 1 month in since transitional from 1170 (Purple) to 300 (GRAY Tris)
 - CDC encouraging limiting interactions of PURPLE and GRAY in provider freezers
 - At the start of Jan 2022, about 20 million PURPLE cap in the field, about 3 million GRAY
 - CDC is pulling controlant reports to see how many shippers are in the field; GRAY and ORANGE are one way shippers and should not be used for storage (protocol different for some islands)
 - Pfizer monitoring digital data loggers.

- **Pfizer Orange Cap**
 - Ordering for Pfizer 5-11 Orange cap is slowing down significantly. 5.7 million kids 5-11 are fully vaccinated as of January 25th, 2022.
 - Current trends are showing significant waste for Pfizer 5-11.

- **J&J**
 - CDC is not refreshing thresholds. Jurisdictions required to send out of cycle requests to HCore.
 - Currently, there are less than 1 million J&J doses in the warehouse.

- 2 million doses for program close out given to the U.S. government. CDC will come back with supply and expiry dates soon.
- J&J shelf life extension and stability package likely in Feb 2022. Currently, most J&J supply is expiring in April (without extension). With shelf life extension, most inventory would last until the end of the summer.
- **Moderna**
 - Still pushing out two ancillary kits per order to allow jurisdictions to administer half dose boosters. However, there are ways to opt out in federal channels through VPop. 19 million ancillaries opted out so far.
 - Same message: no inventory on ancillaries, not going to recover them
 - CDC encouraging providers to opt out of ancillaries if they don't need them
 - Extra ancillaries can be used for flu and other vaccines
 - Domestic use only for ancillaries
 - No news on whether Moderna for adolescents and kids will be available soon.
 - Moderna BLA 18+ could be coming this month.
