INCLUDED BENEFITS & MATERIALS

All exhibitors will have access to the following:

- Conference attendee lists before and after the conference.
- Complimentary conference registrations. Note that exhibitor registrations allow access
 to the full conference and exhibitors are encouraged to attend conference sessions
 during non-exhibit periods. Additional registrations can be purchased from the <u>AIM</u>
 <u>Conference webpage</u>. Complimentary registrations included for each AIM Alliance
 level:
 - 8 for Diamond level
 - 5 for Platinum level
 - 3 for Gold level
 - 1 for Silver level and nonprofit partners
- One 8' x 30" table, two chairs, and house linens. All display materials must fit within the allotted exhibit space. Appropriate exhibit materials include tabletop display, a fast-fold exhibit booth not exceeding 8', and pull-up banners. If you have a question about whether your exhibit materials are appropriate, please ask. There is no pipe and drape, these are tabletop exhibit spaces.
- Garbage cans and water stations will be provided. Power and A/V packages are not included, but can be ordered.
 - Double exhibit booths are available to Platinum- and Diamond-level Alliance partners.
