




To date:

- ✓ Maintained our Annex location as permanent drive-thru for COVID-19 vaccines and testing







- Physician oversight






Community Canvassing allows for direct focus of the surrounding community to a vaccine event location, working outward in widening areas as time allows.






Sample Event Floor Plans

Community Partner

Debrief with the host to allow for clear communication of:

- Formal Thank-you
- Final numbers
- Process Improvement
- Community feedback

Exploration of follow-up vaccination event in 3 weeks

Vaccinated client

Clear availability of information regarding any follow-up doses, as needed:

- ✓ UAMS drive-thru flyer
- ✓ Local clinics that offer the vaccination
- ✓ Additional mobile events in the community

If a follow-up clinic is already scheduled, they can be directly scheduled for that date and time and receive reminders for their scheduled return.



Due to our success with outreach and mobile events, we are exploring expanding services statewide to underserved areas.
