Sorry New to this forum, but on slide 14 for the age 6mo< 5yrs what can be the reason for declined coverage rate?	Two main reasons-- lack of confidence among parents who are choosing not to vaccinate d/t misinformation or a lack of strong recommendation from their child's medical provider and 2) lack of access. While vaccines have great coverage for kids through private insurance or the vaccines for children program, young children cannot be vaccinated at most pharmacies and may not be able to go to their medical home to get a vaccine if it's not a time when they would be seeing their provider for another reason like a well child visit.
Is my memory correct that the peak for infections progresses from south to north in the U.S. over the course of several weeks?	While we do tend to see that with RSV, flu tends to be much more sporadic across the map.
Is the quadrivalent for 65+ accurate on slide 18? I thought all formulations were trivalent since last year...	My error! Thank you for catching that! You are correct, those are trivalent vaccines now. I will correct the slide before we send them out. Thank you for the catch!
Have the monitoring programs for H5N1 been impacted by CDC/FDA/USDA cuts? Wondering if numbers are down just because people stopped looking? Thank you.	We don't have any reason to believe those cuts have impacted H5N1 surveillance and USDA continues to have monthly national calls with interested partners. I think these are true decreases in cases.
how is the decrease in fed funding going to affect the flu distribution	Funding impacts everything and decreases in funding are not homogeneous across the jurisdictions. All programs prioritize VFC and flu vaccine, so I think it's unlikely we'll see major disruptions in distribution of flu vaccine d/t funding to the programs. However, at the provider level, we continue to see reticence to provide a strong recommendation for flu vaccines. That's an area where we really need to put some resources.

And yes, we did also work with cooperative extension.
