Please include a **1-page** maximum justification supporting the nomination (see page 2 of submission form). The nomination document must have **1-inch** margins, be **single-spaced**, and use standard 12-point font. The nomination should describe the nominee's:

- **Contributions to AIM (50 points)** – Impact on AIM's work and development.
- **Contributions to the immunization community (25 points)** – Impact on the field of immunization or immunization program manager community
- **Contributions to jurisdiction(s) and/or local community or organization (25 points)** – Leadership, commitment, and contributions within the jurisdiction(s) or organizations in which the nominee worked

If a submission exceeds two pages total, including submission form page 1, only the content within the page limit will be considered. **Please refer to the [Hall of Fame Reviewer Rubric](#) for scoring details.**
